



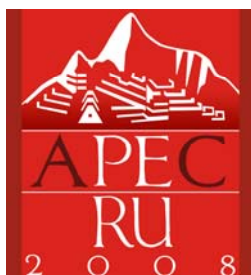

DOCUMENT REPRODUCTION AND DISTRIBUTION

1. Important requirements for submission of meeting documents:

- Submit **all documents in soft copy**. No document will be accepted or reproduced **unless** it is submitted in soft copy together with a **Document Reproduction Request Form (DRRF)** (template attached as **Annex C of the Adm. Circular**) for each document. **The DRRF is necessary for the Documentation Officer to process the paper for the right meeting, for the appropriate agenda item, etc.**
- Submit documents by the stipulated **deadline**. This will allow papers to be uploaded in a timely manner allowing time for their review before they are discussed, avoiding meeting disruption.
- Late submission of documents, though **strongly discouraged**, can be done via the emails below. Again, **only soft copies** will be accepted.
- Indicate clearly, in the email subject field, the name of the meeting and the meeting date(s) for which the papers are being submitted.
- Use separate emails to submit papers for different meetings.
- Please **do not** password-protect your files (Word, PPT, PDF etc) as the Documentation Center will need to insert the standard cover page into each document.

2. Submission of TEL Papers:

All documents and Power Point presentation for the any TEL Meeting must be submitted in **soft copy** via email to the APEC Secretariat and Documentation liaison of the host economy.

All TEL documents **must** be accompanied by a **soft copy** of a one-page **Executive Summary (Annex D of the Adm. Circular)**, outlining decision points and/or deliberations required from the TEL. Each document must be submitted with a Documentation Reproduction Request Form-DRRF.
