

## LAW N° 28774

### **LAW ESTABLISHING NATIONAL REGISTRY OF CELLULAR TELEPHONY TERMINALS, PROHIBITIONS AND CRIMINALLY SANCTIONING THOSE MODIFYING AND COMMERCIALIZING MOVIL PHONES OF QUESTIONABLE ORIGIN**

#### **Article 1°.- Registry's Establishment**

Establish the National Registry of Cellular Telephony in charge of operators enterprises of cellular telephony terminals under the supervision of the Ministry of Transportation and Communications and the The Supervising Agency of Telecommunications Private Investment, OSIPTEL.

#### **Article 2°.- Registry's Objective**

The objective of the National Registry of Cellular Telephony Terminals is to register the mark, model, stock, numbering and ownership of cellular phones commercialised by enterprises of the authorized label to contrast it with the ones reported as stolen or lost before the Concessionaire Enterprises.

#### **Article 3°.- Prohibition**

Concessionaire Enterprises of Mobile Telephony Service are prohibited to enable mobile telephony lines at telephone terminals that have been reported as stolen under civil and penal responsibility.

#### **Article 4°.- Criminal Code's Amendment**

Add to Articles 222°-A to the Criminal Code with the following text:

#### **“SANCTION OF CELLULAR TELEPHONY TERMINALS ADULTERY OR CLONATION”**

**Article 222°-A .-** The amendment, replacement, duplication or any kind of line number or electronic or mechanic stock of a cellular terminal's modification that could harm the subscriber or the user him/herself as third persons, will be repress with freedom cause of privation no lower than sixty (60) to three hundred and sixty five (365) days of sanction.

#### **TRANSITORY ARRANGEMENT**

**Single .-** The Ministry of Transportation and Communication as OSIPTEL are responsible of ruling this standard.

Inform the President of the Republic for its announcement.
